Peace can feel so broad and big that it is easy to keep it abstract. Martin Luther King, Jr. is well known for his "I have a Dream" speech. What is your dream of peace for your congregation? Make it practical. Do you need to focus within your body or outside? Acts of peace spring from the deep well of Jesus Christ. Conclude with a time of silent reflection while instrumental music is played.
