 - 3 to speak,
 - 2 to speak about God,
 - 1 declaring the wonders of God,
 - 2 proclaiming God's marvelous acts.
 - 1 The crowd heard,
 - 2 they heard the sound.
 - 3 They heard the speaking.
 - 2 They heard,
 - 1 they heard and were
 - 2 amazed.
 - 1 They heard
 - 2 each in her own language,





- 1, 2, 3 each in his own tongue.
 - 1 They were amazed,
 - 2 perplexed,
 - 3 puzzled.
- 1, 2, 3 "What does this mean?"
 - 1 they asked.
 - 2 Ask Joel.
 - 3 Joel has told us
 - 1 that God says,
- 1, 2, 3 I will pour out my Spirit on all people.

Your sons and daughters will prophecy.

I will pour out my Spirit,

And everyone who calls,

who calls on the name of the Lord,

will be saved.

- 1 Peter said,
- 1, 2, 3 Repent.
 - 1 Repent and be baptized,
 - 2 be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ
 - 1 so
 - 2 that
 - 3 your sins
 - 2 may be
 - 3 forgiven.
 - 2 And you will receive,
 - 3 receive the gift,
 - 1 receive the power,
- 1, 2, 3 receive the power of the Holy Spirit.
