People: we trust that we will not only endure but thrive as a living body.

People: may we provide a spiritual home where children will be richly and safely

nurtured.

Leader: As the wood of the Linden tree is fine grained, soft and workable without splin-

tering,

People: may we remain pliable and open to be shaped in God's image.

Leader: As the flowers, leaves and wood have medicinal qualities,

People: may our fellowship be a balm for spiritual and emotional wounds.

Leader: As the meaning of the name "linden" is lenient or yielding,
